CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF DEEP RIVER

BY-LAW NO. 5-86

WHEREAS, under the authority of R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 315, paragraph 1, the Councils of all Municipalities may pass By-Laws "for prohibiting or regulating the obstructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways";

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to enact such a By-Law to prohibit the obstructing or encumbering of any highway;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Deep River ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

In this By-Law: "Highway" means "Highway" as defined in the Highway Traffic Act.

"Roadway" means "Roadway" as defined in the Highway Traffic Act.

"Superintendent" means the Superintendent of Public Works of the Town of Deep River

- 1. The depositing of snow or ice on any roadway within the limits of the Town of Deep River shall be deemed to be an encumbrance of the highway within the meaning of the aforesaid Section 315, paragraph 1.
- No person shall, for the purpose of cleaning or clearing of any driveway or other property or for any other purpose, deposit or cause to be deposited snow or ice from such driveway or property on any roadway.
- 3. The provisions of this By-Law shall not apply to the Superintendent when acting in such capacity, or to any person as an employee under the Superintendent's direction.
- 4. Any person contravening the provisions of this By-Law shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 exclusive of costs.

And that By-Law No. 4-79 is hereby repealed.
